Purchasing Division

- Bids may be directly solicited from vendors for procurements up to \$15,000
- Not only does MTA purchase specialized, transit specific, parts for buses and rail cars, the agency purchases many general Maintenance, Repair & Operations (MRO) items including parts, small tools, supplies, consumables, uniforms, etc.
